A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COUNTRY WALK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DESIGNATING DATES, TIME AND LOCATION FOR REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE DISTRICT, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Country Walk Community Development District (hereinafter the "District") is a local unit of special-purpose government created and existing pursuant to Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, being situated entirely within Pasco County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the District's Board of Supervisors (hereinafter the "Board") is statutorily authorized to exercise the powers granted to the District; and

WHEREAS, all meetings of the Board shall be open to the public and governed by the provisions of Chapter 286, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board is statutorily required to file annually, with the local governing authority and the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, a schedule of its regular meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COUNTRY WALK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Regular meetings of the Board of Supervisors of the District shall be held as provided on the schedule attached as Exhibit "A".

<u>Section 2</u>. In accordance with Section 189.015(1), Florida Statutes, the District's Secretary is hereby directed to file annually, with Pasco County, a schedule of the District's regular meetings.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

LIEN LAW

YOU ARE NOT OBLIGATED TO ACCEPT ANY OFFER WHICH MAY BE MADE. THERE ARE STRICT DEADLINES AND PROCEDURES UNDER THIS FLORIDA LAW WHICH MUST BE MET AND FOLLOWED TO PROTECT YOUR INTERESTS.

Customer is responsible for any and all attorney fees related to their dispute. Contractor's Workmanship Warranty will become null and void if contract is not paid in full. Payments not rendered in accordance with contract agreement shall be subject to finance charges of 18%. Interior water damage will be covered for 12 months from time of job completion.

All proposals are based upon cash/check pricing unless otherwise noted. A 5% processing fee will be added to all credit card orders. Additional financing charges may apply if applicable.

There is a \$35.00 N.S.F. Fee for all returned checks. In the event of collection, debtor is to pay all attorney's fees, costs and expense incurred therein regardless of whether Final Judgement is rendered. These terms and conditions will be enforced.


